

**Farmer Experiences with the On-Farm Climate Action Fund:
Doug Stone – Bokma Farms**



Perennia’s OFCAF Technical Lead, Georgia Lewis, spent the morning with Doug Stone, a partner at Bokma Farms Ltd, to discuss how the On-Farm Climate Action Fund program supported changes to their operations.



Doug and the team at Bokma Farms wanted to explore using cover crops to maintain soil health through variable winter events, and OFCAF helped them by supporting the purchase of an APV air seeder. The seeder was mounted on a frame with sprayer booms for a more broad and consistent coverage while seeding. The benefits were noticeable in the first year of use, said Doug.

“This spring, the benefits of the cover crops was very apparent due to the amount of precipitation we had between last summer and this spring. In the fields where we had a really good catch of cover crops, there were very few wash outs and most of the soil was where it was supposed to be.”
