- Evaluating and refining current rotational grazing practices

This opportunity is best suited for producers who:

- Are currently implementing rotational grazing within their operation
- Are motivated to improve efficiencies, production and profitability
- Are open to learning, adapting and applying new management approaches

Funding support may be available to assist with participation costs, however, this will depend on the level of interest expressed by producers across the province. At this stage, we are seeking expressions of interest to better understand potential participation and inform next steps.
